POSITION PURPOSE

Parks Specialist – Horticulture is responsible for the design, implementation, management, and mapping of selected gardens throughout the City. Main emphasis will be on design, propagation, planting, and maintenance of perennial displays, annual displays and maintenance of interior foliage. Work is done under the direct supervision of the Crewleader – Horticulture.

Required:
